# Our Learnings

- We are sitting in the same boat – no matter which level, position or structure)
- We have to promote our unique selling points (and need to know them)
- We can be proud of what we have achieved in 25-30 rural development, but spending some funding-money is too less to be famous for
- On local level people do not care from which pocket the help/network/money comes



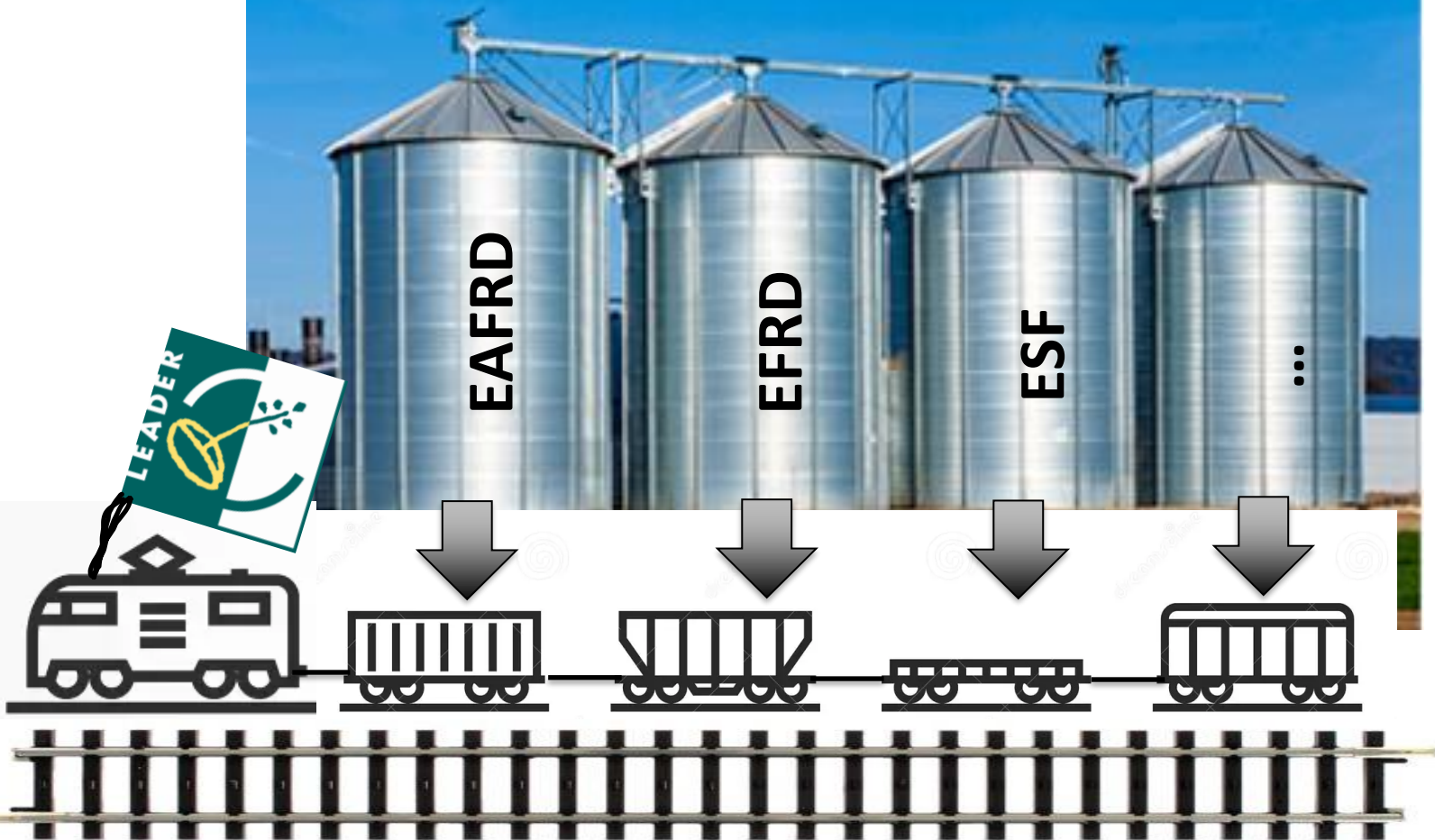


This was the picture...

# What have we done...

- **Governance process** which started already 2006
- Focus on the **needs in the regions** and not on the needs of the different funding regimes
- It is not about what is better, top-down or bottom-up. It is about the best output...
- **Political decision**, that there is only **one** organisation for rural development on regional level (between 20.000 – 120.000 inhabitants)
- **Multifund** approach since 2014, „Multifund-light“ since 2001
- LEADER is not the main funding source, but the **main method** approach (no matter which fund)
- Create a **one-stop-shop system** on regional AND on administrative level
