


What is the New European Bauhaus?

The **New European Bauhaus** (NEB) is an environmental, economic, and cultural initiative launched by the European Commission in 2020 and **co-created** with stakeholders across sectors.





- The NEB Lab of the Mountains aims to co-create socioecological transformation in mountain areas. The Lab works on implementing the New European Bauhaus at the regional level, with a first focus on South Tyrol's mountainous area.
- The lab works on 7 thematic clusters:
- sustainability and affordable housing
- valorisation of sustainable and beautiful built environment
- circular design and bio economy
- art and democracy
- creative industries and inclusive society
- design and art of education
- digital transformation for the common good

NEB Lighthouse Demonstrator in Riga:

How to apply circularity principles to adapt a 40year old Soviet building to modern living standards? Transformation of a five-story building (empty since 2018) to house families with physical and mental disabilities + multiple social services and community centres for the neighbourhood.

DESIRE: 8 transformation sites in 8 neighbourhoods across Europe

Desire experiments with creating sustainable, attractive, and inclusive urban spaces which respect the limited resources of the planet.

NEB-STAR: connecting climate-friendly cities by working together with people and organisations in Stavanger, Prague and Utrecht.



CultuurCampus: makeing Rotterdam South a better place to live and learn by combining culture, education, research and policy.



EHHUR: supporting cities and people by changing their surroundings with their eyes, hearts and hands in seven countries: Denmark, Greece, Belgium, Portugal, Turkey, Croatia and Italy.



DESIRE: creating sustainable, attractive, and inclusive urban spaces which respect the limited resources of the planet in interaction with citizens, artists, urban planners, contractors, builders...



NEBourhoods: prepares Munich-Neuperlach (DE) for the future as mapped out by the <u>European Green Deal</u> when it comes to the built environment, circularity, mobility, energy, food, and health.



CrAFt: will support all 5 selected projects, as well as future NEB lighthouse project. Test collaborative local models for NEB transformations in 3 'sandbox cities' and guide the 100 cities selected under the 'Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities' Mission.
