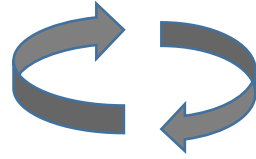

Vulnerability of territories



Eco-climatic crisis

accumulation of conditions that disrupt environmental rhythms and balances:
changing temperatures, increasing extreme events, hydro-geological disruption, loss and change in biodiversity,
...conditions related to the socio-political nature of the environment

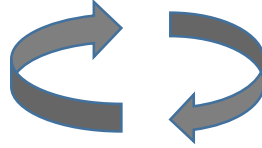

Toward socio-environmental and landscape justice

A declination of justice in the configurations of territoriality



- environmental goods as social values
- secular human-non-human relationship that guarantees the balance of territories
- right to enjoyment of environmental goods also by "weak" actors

- landscape as a guardian of the material heritage and knowledge that has been handed down over time
- right that guarantees the identity of communities and protects their belonging to the territory
- right of enjoyment even by other external actors because of its universal and changeable value depending on the observer, without undermining the right of local communities
