

#### **Cohesion policy for all EU regions and cities**



Cohesion policy contributes to strengthening economic, social and territorial cohesion in the European Union.

It aims to correct imbalances between countries and regions, and delivers on the Union's political priorities

#### Cohesion policy 2021-2027 EUR 392 billion:

- 1) Investment for jobs and growth goal
- 2) Interreg European Territorial Cooperation goal



## Cohesion policy - EU's main investment policy delivered through specific funds

- The <u>European Regional Development Fund (ERDF)</u>, to invest in the social and economic development of all EU regions and cities.
- The <u>Cohesion Fund (CF)</u>, to invest in environment and transport in the less prosperous EU countries.
- The <u>European Social Fund Plus (ESF+)</u>, to support jobs and create a fair and socially inclusive society in EU countries.
- The <u>Just Transition Fund (JTF)</u> to support the regions most affected by the transition towards climate neutrality.
- In cooperation with the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and the European Maritime, Fisheries, and Aquaculture Fund (EMFAF), other EU policies

# Territorial dimension in the legal framework 2021-2027

# Common Provisions Regulation (links with other EU funds)

- Policy objectives
- Territorial development with requirements for integrated territorial development and tools to use:
  - > ITI
  - > CLLD
  - Another tool (recognises nationally developed tools for integrated territorial strategies)

#### **ERDF/CF Regulation**

- Specific objectives with urban/territorial dimension (Policy Objective 5 'Europe closer to citizens')
- Sustainable urban development (min. 8% ERDF) accompanied by European Urban Initiative.

#### **ESF+ Regulation**

 contributes to territorial and local development strategies in view of tackling the socioeconomic inequalities in cities and regions

#### **Interreg regulation**

- Interregional cooperation
  - Including URBACT and ESPON programmes

**4. A more social and inclusive Europe** implementing the European Pillar of Social Rights



- 5. A Europe closer to citizens Europe closer to citizens by fostering sustainable and integrated development of all types of territories and local initiatives
  - integrated and inclusive social, economic and environmental development, culture, natural heritage, sustainable tourism security

# Cohesion policy 2021-27: harmonised framework for integrated territorial development

- Harmonised framework for territorial and local strategies, dedicated policy objective
   5 and territorial delivery mechanism
- Specific method and minimum requirements for strategies: geographical area, analysis of needs and potential, integrated multi-thematic strategy, partnership involvement under the responsibility of relevant territorial authorities or bodies
- At least 8% of ERDF to sustainable urban development strategies, with recommended focus on functional urban areas. Non-urban territorial strategies invited to target rural, mountainous, insular, sparsely populated areas etc., urban-rural linkages
- Territorial delivery mechanisms to use for both urban and other areas:
  - Integrated Territorial Investment (ITI)
  - Community-led Local Development (CLLD)
  - Another tool recognising nationally developed tools



# 'Europe closer to citizens' approach to territorial and local development

Entails a **specific method** of integrated territorial development requiring territorial or local development strategies that are place-based, integrated, and involve relevant partners in preparation and implementation of the strategy, under the responsibility of relevant territorial authority/body.

For urban areas:
Minimum 8% of
ERDF at national
level

European Urban Initiative (EUI) - capacity building and knowledge

Urban-rural linkages, functional areas

New: Policy Objective 5 - a "crosscutting territorial policy objective" for integrated and sustainable development of urban and non-

urban territories

#### **Territorial tools to use:**

ITI, CLLD or another territorial tool (national)
