The use of an ITI in rural areas in Piemonte


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Most Italian regions have employed the ITI instrument in rural contexts to implement the National Strategy for Inner Areas.

The National Strategy for Inner Areas (NSIA) represents an innovative national policy for territorial development and cohesion that aims to counteract marginalization and demographic decline phenomena in specific areas.




The predominance of Inner Areas within mountainous and rural territories has highlighted the connection between ITI and rural policy implementation.

National average overlap: 91%


100% overlap: Veneto, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Emilia-

Integration and political collaboration

- 74% of SNAI areas integrate objectives and policies with the LAGs
- 14% of SNAI strategies plan the implementation of actions aligned with the objectives of the LAGs
- 12% of SNAI areas show no integration with the LAGs' strategies



Closing remarks and reccomandations

- Redefinition of areas based on Leader programming tools for more effective interventions.
- Temporal alignment of SNAI and LEADER programming.
- Activation of a structured coordination between the different strategies at central, regional, and local levels.
- Transition from single-fund LAGs to multi-fund LAGs.
- Promotion and support for the creation of shared local partnerships within the two strategies.

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
