## Follow-up actions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> RPCG meeting (16 April 2024) – Focus on letter sending and tracking process

- Translated letters to the governments and note to the candidate MEPs promoting the Rural Pact and action for rural areas by RPCG members and RPSO national experts
- At RPCG request, use of the co-signature of the letters by the RPCG Chair to strengthen the impact of these letters
- RPCG members to encourage governments to make political commitments to the Rural
   Pact to be published in a dedicated webpage in the Rural Pact Community Platform.
- RPCG progress on sending the letters and notes communicated to RPSO, specifying to which Ministries/MEPs were the letters sent and any feedback received or other actions and contacts carried out (<u>Google Drive</u>).
