

Forestry Sector in Cuenca (Spain): Key Figures and Characteristics:

- 1. Forest Area:** Over 850,000 hectares (60% of the province's surface).
- 2. Economic Importance:** traditional forest activities: logging, resin extraction, recreation activities and hunting-related services.
- 3. Population Context:** 196,000 inhabitants, with a low population density (<13 inhabitants/km²).
- 4. Timber Production:** Top provinces in timber production (300,000 to 400,000 m³, from sustainable forest management plans).
=> sawmills, pellet producers, and small-scale artisanal woodcraft enterprises.
- 5. Non-Timber Forest Products (NTFPs)**
=> Resin tapping, Mushrooms and truffles, Medicinal and aromatic plants, Hunting and tourism
- 6. Natural protected areas, biodiversity conservation, ecosystem services**






