Valuing food and fostering fair living and working conditions in vibrant rural areas



A sector where food is valued and offers a fair living and working condition in rural areas

Main actions (focus on rural)


- Synergies and complementarities must be further enhanced

- Establishing a Women in Farming Platform








- European Commission Communication on the road towards the next Multiannual Financial Framework after 2027 – published on 11 February 2025.
- The Communication points at the importance of food security. It calls the CAP to be simpler, more targeted and to find the right balance between incentives, investment and regulations and to ensure a fair income for the farmers. Explores one plan per Member State for all policies.
- Speech by the President at the Annual EU Budget Conference 2025 (20 May) : "In our next Budget, there will be a central place for Cohesion Policy and the Common Agricultural Policy. Modernised and better adapted to todays' challenges. Our regions and our farmers will always be at the heart of our Union".
