

ITI Water and Landscape Ecosystems - Integrated Territorial Instrument

Participatory process → public actors, private actors, and LAGs

Central themes: Water and Landscape Ecosystems

Objective: to address the impacts of these themes on the territory and communities.


Ambition: to generate innovative solutions, knowledge, and wealth.

Vision: to transform the region into an attractive, sustainable, and cohesive territory, through the coordination of different funds in the same area.

Focus: water management, ecosystem preservation, climate adaptation.

An **integrated approach** that addresses identified development needs and the territory's potential.





Synergies: CLLD + ITI

Strategic combination:

- **CLLD** → proximity, community mobilization
- ITI → large-scale investment and ecological infrastructure

Benefits:

- > Greater water and ecological resilience
- > Water and landscape as strategic assets for the future
- > Active community involvement in resource management
- > Local communities as central actors in the ecological transition
- > Alignment between local and regional policies
 - CLLD + ITI = mutual reinforcement for rural resilience
 - Empowered communities build resilient landscapes
