LAGs are important actors in building resilient, competitive, and sustainable communities—communities with wellbeing—and through their activities, they contribute to balancing living conditions everywhere (which is in line with the goals of cohesion policy and is key to regional development).

LAGs in Czechia are key actors in implementing social inclusion agendas in small municipalities and remote areas, and they serve as knowledge-based entities and innovation brokers.

CLLD IN CZECHIA: KEY MESSAGES









The **multi-sectoral** nature of LAGs and their **synergistic effects** lead to **greater efficiency** in the use of resources.

This is made possible thanks to the **multi-fund financing of CLLD and multisectoral approach**—continuation in the 2028+ programming period is **essential**.

Moreover, the **integrated and place-based approach** should become a **fundamental** principle in the European legislation for the 2028+, automatically applied in the implementation of cohesion policy.

CLLD IN CZECHIA: KEY MESSAGES









It is vital to strenghten CLLD and territorial approaches further also within ESF and ERDF and there is a need to enhance capacity building by the European Commission towards ESF and ERDF Managing Authorities.

It is important to **enhance both vertical and horizontal communication** channels and mechanisms for information exchange among LAGs, municipalities, regional authorities, and ministries.

Alongside, **simplify** the administrative framework for CLLD (European and national level).
