




Population change

(% of total population, 1 January 2014–24)





Ageing population

Change in population of age group 20-64, 2014-2021











Target regions of the Talent Booster Mechanism

- **16 countries** with acute demographic challenges
- 46 regions affected by sharp workforce decline and low/stagnating share of tertiary educated in a talent development trap (red).
- **36 regions** with net out-migration of their younger cohort at risk of falling into a talent development trap (yellow).


11 regions received expert support in 2024 to attract, develop and retain talent

4 cities receiving financial assistance from EUI for testing innovative solutions for harnessing talent





