

Ten shared goals for joint action



- II. **Engaged in multi-level and place-based governance**, developing integrated strategies using collaborative and participatory approaches.
- ▶ III. Providers of food security, economic opportunities, goods and services for wider society.
- IV. Dynamic communities focusing on well-being.
- V. **Inclusive communities** of inter-generational solidarity fairness and renewal, open to newcomers and fostering equal opportunities for all.
- VI. **Flourishing sources of nature**, enhanced by and contributing to the objectives of the Green Deal...
