

WHERE WE ARE (Situation)



"It's never easy to design a new framework, but this has been particularly difficult." (Catherine Geslain-Lanéelle)

- Several competing priorities (security, competitiveness, etc.)
- ► Some of the things we asked for: integrated approach no silos
- ▶ Obligation to keep the **territorial focus**, as well as territorial **tracking**
- Flexibility: agile framework
- The possibility to **create synergies** through integrated territorial development strategies
- ► It comes at a price: risk that the the 'nonallocated' money will not go to rural areas

WHAT IS MISSING (Complication)



"In principle the integrated approach is an opportunity, in practice it's a total disaster." (Marianne Selkainaho)

- Ring-fence funding for rural development, LEADER & Smart Villages
- ► Territorial tracking is crucial as well as how we define rural
- Empower local rural communities & people in territorial cohesion –
 ensure rural proofing
- ► Guarantee genuine multi-level partnership Rural Pact model
- Strengthen data availability and evidence on rural territories (what is rural?)

We can be part of the conversation with the co-legislator (EP...), but the co-legislator disagrees with the proposal, partly because there is no security for 'rural development' goal ...

CHANGE or REJECT?

- Form alliances: Rural Pact Community / Rural Pact Coordination Group is an 'alliance'. Cohesion policy & rural policy. All rural citizens & farmers.
- **Be specific**: e.g. concrete **legislative proposals** (RPCG, ELARD, SVNS). Define methodology on what is rural (and how it benefits the local community level)
- ► Act at all levels: Inspiring national/ regional examples follow their example!
