Active participation in preparation and implementation of national and regional programs

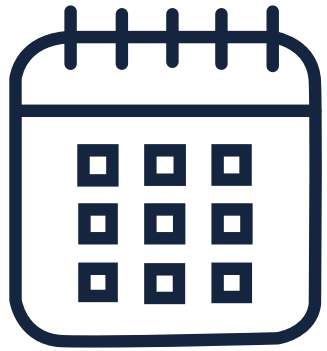

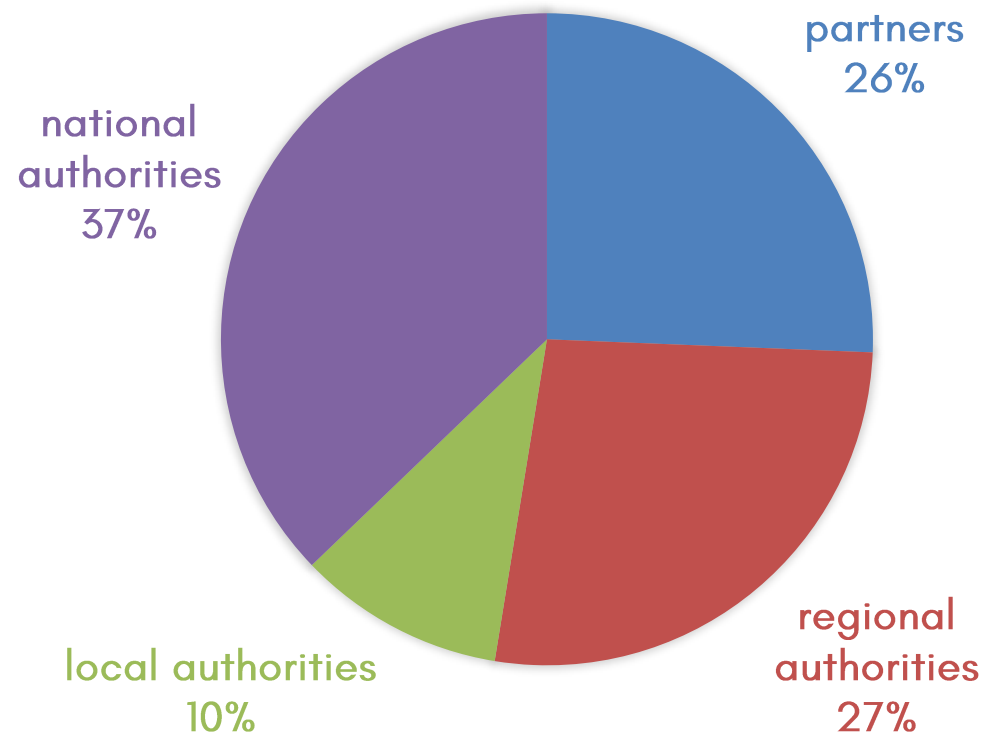

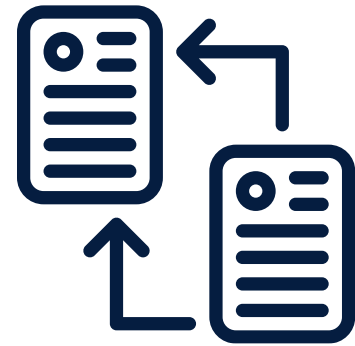
